

Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School is located in Doylestown, Ohio, and was founded in 1862. The small community it served still remains a village.

Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church is the oldest Catholic Church in the Diocese of Cleveland. There is a strong presence of Catholics in the community, many of whom descend from the pioneering families that founded the Church.

The present Principal is moving and will not be able to continue after this year. There are nine classroom teachers and four special-subjects teachers: music, art, physical education and computer technology. Additionally, we are served by a speech therapist, a remedial teacher and a psychologist through Auxiliary Services. Presently, the school has 129 students, grades K-8, and 141 are registered for the coming year.

The candidate for the position must have a strong Catholic presence, both in practice and in knowledge; have at least five years of varied teaching experiences; possess a Masters Degree and administrative licensure [or be working toward each]; have a comprehensive understanding of primary and upper grade curricula; have a vibrant personality to articulate with a parent body that is heavily involved with the school; and have experience in or is committed to support technology.
